Fete/Dimension IV – Urban Infill

New construction (urban infill) in a key redevelopment district. Project is also a part of the “Main Street” program. Two story masonry construction, 3,000 s.f. each floor. Combines specialty retail shop at street level with second floor architectural studio. Incorporates green and sustainable concepts. Multiple design/project awards.



Main Street Commons – Mixed Use Redevelopment

Renovation of glove factory into a mixed-use commercial building. Maximized use of existing features (brick walls, wood floors, concrete and steel structure) while also updating the facility to meet current codes. Approximately 28,000 s.f.

Sunnybrook Meadows – Residential Development

14 acre, 152 unit mixed residential development. Two 3-story community living buildings flank a central common space. Underground parking, outdoor balconies, community service space, spacious apartments and walking trails characterize this senior development. One and two story condominium units transition the development from the surrounding single-family homes.
